



10th-11th FEBRUARY 2022: CONFERENCE OF AFRICAN AND EUROPEAN CIVIL SOCIETY

As the heads of state from Africa and Europe will meet at the 6th African Union-European union summit on the 17th and 18th February 2022, it is necessary that **African and European civil society meet to exchange and promote a fair partnership, equal and sustainable**, in order to prepare this summit and the future of relations between Africa and the European Union.

The Conference of African and European Civil Societies will be organized by <u>Coordination</u> <u>SUD</u>, the French platform for international solidarity NGOs, with its African and European partners, including <u>FORUS</u> et <u>CONCORD Europe</u>. This conference will offer **two days of exchange and debate**, in order to allow African and European civil societies to meet, to discuss the current strategic partnership, and to build common positions for the future of relations between the two continents. Through several panel talks, round tables, and discussion groups, the representatives of African and European civil societies will share their analysis of the Africa-EU partnership and discuss the need to develop these relations towards an open partnership, fair and sustainable for both continents. **The space and role of civil society** will thus be at the heart of the challenges of this conference, alongside in particular **human rights**, **sustainable development**, **digital technology**, **women** and **youth**.

Thanks to the participation of a diversity of civil society actors, common positions will be formulated in order to prepare the activities that will be carried out around the AU-EU summit, in order to make the voice of civil societies heard at the institutional level.

This conference will be organized within the framework of the project "**Towards an open**, **fair and sustainable Europe in the world**", funded by the European Commission, and implemented by a European consortium of NGO platforms: Concord Sweden, Coordination SUD, FoRS and Concord Europe.
